SERVICE

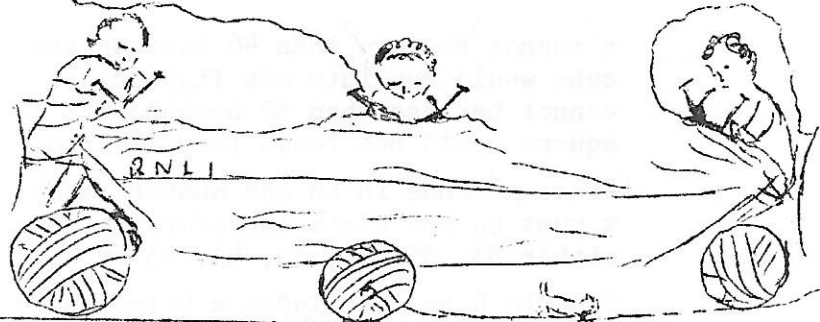
There will be a short Christian Service in the Liberal Studies Area on Sunday next at the EARLIER TIME OF 09.40.

PUZZLE CORNER

Answers to Last Week's Puzzles

1. Here is the solution accompanied by a few lines of reasoning:

x cannot be more than 46 because its cube would run into six figures. It cannot be less than 32 because its square would not reach four figures.

Since x^3 ends in an odd number, then x must be odd also. Therefore it is either 33, 35, 37, 39, 41, 43 or 45.

Clue to 6 ac. precludes x being above 41 or the answer would be four figures not three.

Clue to 3 dn. cuts out 33, 35 and 39 since either of their cubes reversed added to their cubes gives a six-figure answer.

Only 37 or 41 is therefore a possible value for x and only 41 satisfies all clues.
